**SAFESCHOOLS ALERT INITIATIVE:**

This month the School District of Horicon will be initiating a new school safety program that will allow students, parents and the community to notify the school district of any possible safety concerns.



Safety is one of our District's top priorities. To help safeguard our school community, the District has taken an important step that we want to share with you.

Our District is now using *SafeSchools Alert*, a tip-reporting service that allows students, staff, and parents to submit safety concerns to our administration five different ways:

You and your child can easily report tips on bullying, harassment, drugs, vandalism or any safety issue you are concerned about for a specific school (Van Brunt or Jr/Sr High School) through the SafeSchools Alert system.

Every tip SafeSchools Alert receives about our district is immediately logged in the system and our administration is notified so that they can investigate and take appropriate action.

These alerts can be made anonymously should you prefer to do so.
