WINTER WEATHER INFORMATION

Inclement weather may require us to delay school starting times, cancel school or dismiss school early. In all cases of closings, delayed starts, or early dismissals, the safety of children will be considered first. The normal procedure is to check with law enforcement agencies, the bus company, and the weather service. We also use the Dodge County Weather Alert System. The first alert prior to 6:00 a.m. will either cancel school or give information regarding a late start. If we announce a late start, buses will run approximately two hours later than normal. All students will be dismissed at the usual times should delayed starts be necessary. A second alert (no later than 8:00 a.m.) may be made to cancel school.




