6th grade Exploratory Spanish (A/B days)

UNIT 1: Where is Spanish spoken?

Students will be able to:

- Identify the Spanish speaking countries of the world.
- Identify the capitals of the Spanish speaking countries

UNIT 2: Spanish pronunciation and the alphabet

Students will be able to:

- Use the Spanish alphabet to spell their names.
- Identify unique sounds and letters.
- Read Spanish at a novice level.

UNIT 3: Numbers 0-100

Students will be able to:

- Identify numbers 0-100.
- Spell out the numbers in word form.
- Calculate basic addition and subtraction using numbers.

UNIT 4: Conversation phrases

Students will be able to:

- Identify common greetings, questions/responses and miscellaneous phrases to have conversations.
- Use Spanish to have basic introductory conversations with classmates.

UNIT 5: Days of week, months, colors

Students will be able to:

- Compare and contrast American and Mexican calendars.
- Give the date using month/day/year format.
- Create a calendar using all vocabulary up to this point.

UNIT 6: Family

Students will be able to:

- Identify family members in Spanish.
- Explain the difference between gendered nouns.
- Create a family tree using unit vocabulary.
