

Horicon High School Student Parking Rules and Regulations

The Horicon Public School District is not responsible for property, which is lost, stolen or damaged while in the Horicon High School Parking Lot.

Students must be issued a parking permit before they may park in the student parking facility. The administrative rules governing student use of automobiles are listed below.

Rules and Regulations

1. The yearly \$40.00 fee will be required before a parking permit tag will be issued. Pro-rated fees will be applicable throughout the year by quarter.
2. Applicants must possess a valid driver's license. A prorated fee will be available for those students obtaining their license after the start of the school year.
3. Lost or stolen tags can be replaced at a cost of \$10.00.
4. Application forms must contain the student's name, and the license number of the vehicle authorized to display the permit, the student's driver's license number, and the signatures of the student and/or a parent/guardian.
5. Parents/Guardians/students 18 years of age or older must certify that the vehicle(s) described on the application is insured and must carry liability insurance.
6. Applicants with outstanding fines, fees, detentions, excessive points or other school related violations may have their parking permit revoked.
7. Only vehicles with a permit tag for student parking will be allowed to park in the lot during normal school hours.
8. Students must report the loss or theft of their permit tag to administration immediately.
9. Once the lot is entered, the vehicle must be parked, vacated and locked immediately.
10. Vehicles are allowed to leave the parking lot only during the student's designated lunch period, after school, or when authorized by attendance office, health office or administration.
11. Smoking is prohibited in vehicles parked in the student parking lot and on school grounds. A citation **will** be issued and possible suspension/revocation of parking privileges.
12. Loitering and littering in the parking lot is prohibited. Violation of this policy may result in a citation and/or suspension/revocation of parking privileges.
13. Excessive speed or noise (engines, tires, squealing, radio/stereo, alarms, etc.) is prohibited. Violations can result in forfeiture of parking privileges.
14. All traffic regulations must be obeyed.
15. Forgotten parking tag will result in having to use street parking.

Statements

A student's parking permit may be suspended or revoked for violations that include, but are not limited to, the following statements.

1. Parking tags must be located on the inside rear view mirror with the permit number clearly visible from the outside. Vehicles must be pulled into their space and not backed in. Vehicles are to park in one spot only. Vehicles not displaying a parking tag properly, displaying an unauthorized tag, or found parked illegally will be subject to a parking fine and/or towing.
2. Unauthorized parked vehicles will be ticketed and may be towed at owners' expense.
3. Any changes of authorized users must be requested in writing by the student and a parent/guardian.
4. Students with special circumstances (scheduling or curriculum concerns) will be issued parking tags at the cost of \$40.00 if space is available.
5. Suspension(s) from the student parking lot may result in a total revocation of privileges.
6. Parking permits may be suspended or revoked if the student is habitually truant, violates school board policies, or rules, interferes with instructional operations, disrupts normal school operation, creates a safety hazard, is a nuisance to students, area property owners or residence.
7. The Administration of Horicon High School, for any behavior deemed inappropriate, may revoke student-parking privileges.
8. There will be no refund of money to any student who has had their parking privilege revoked or suspended due to violation of Horicon High School Student Parking rules, regulations and/or policies.
