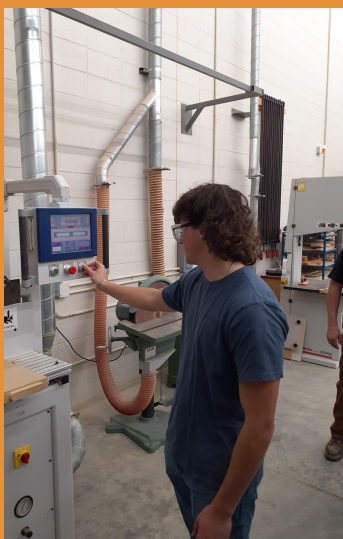

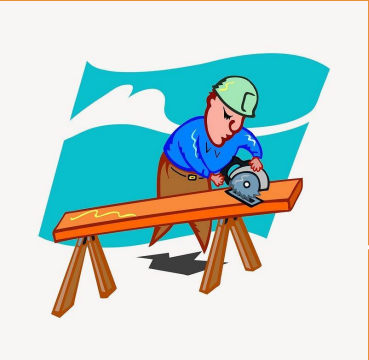

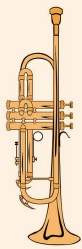
Fox Valley Tech. College Hands on High Tech Event

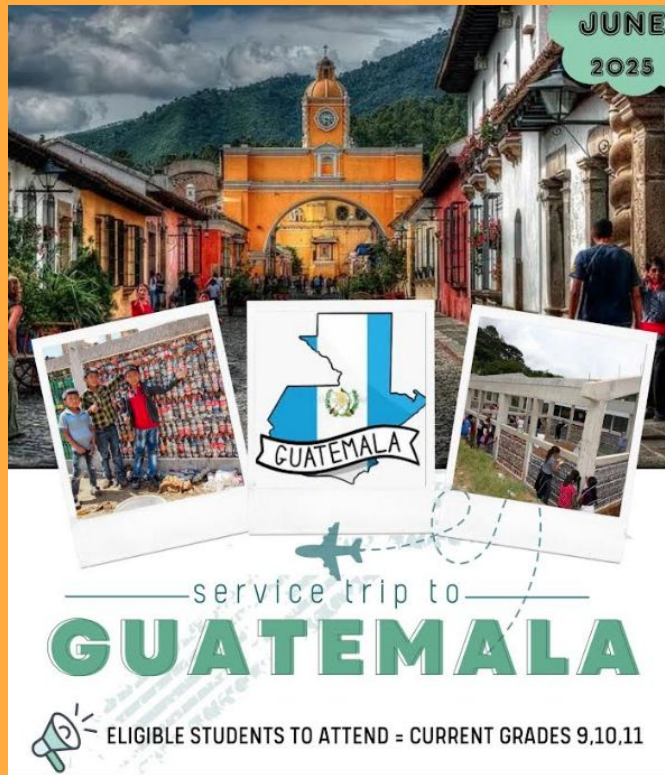

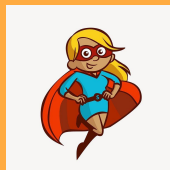

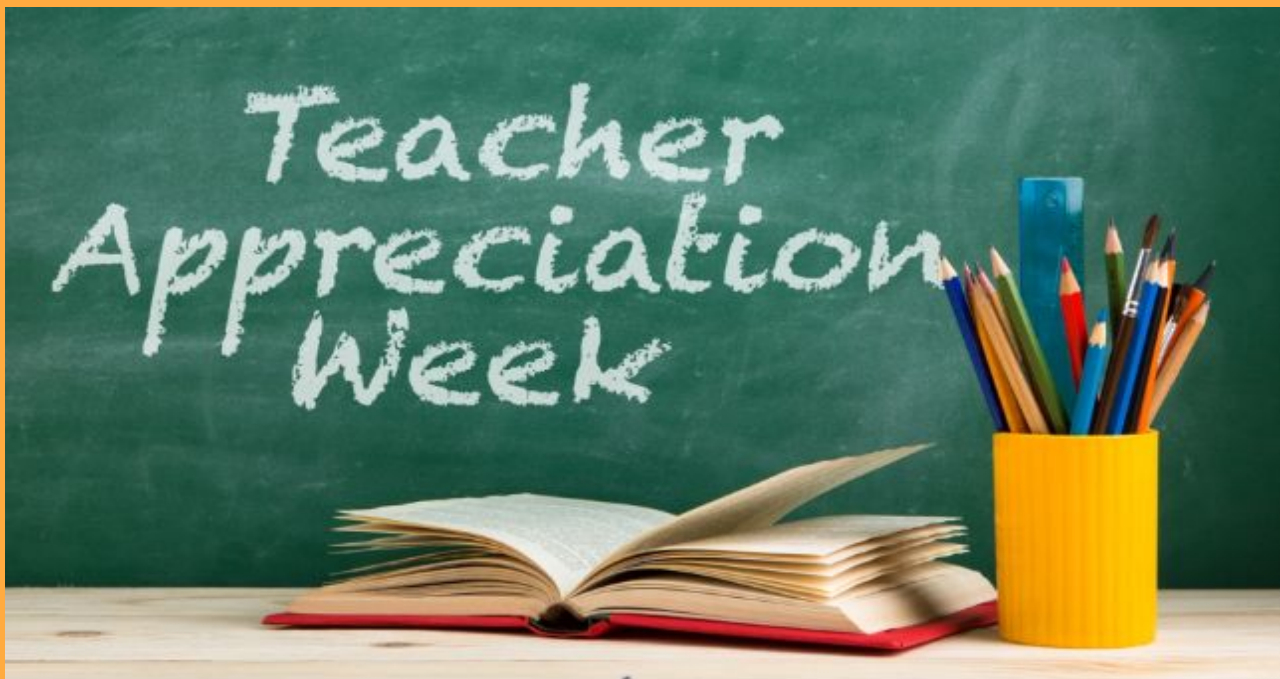
