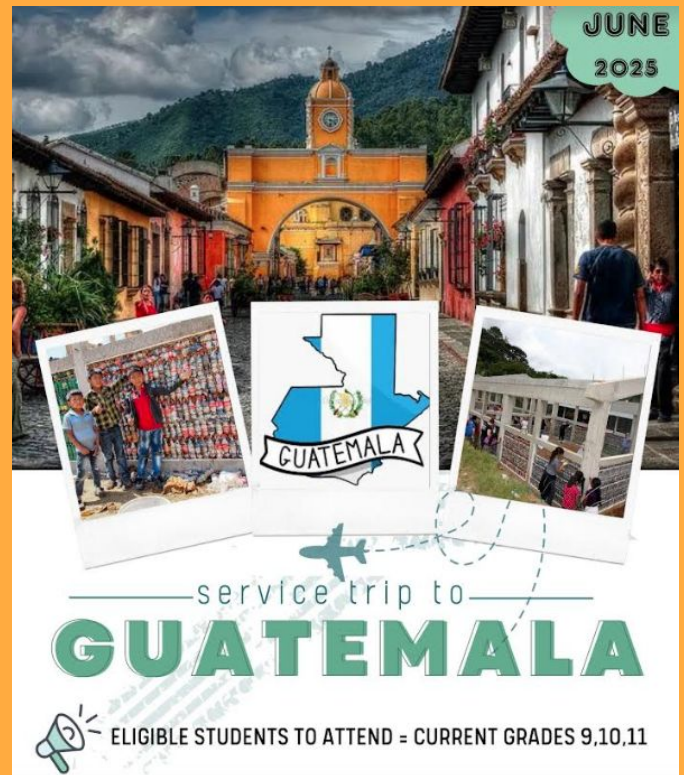

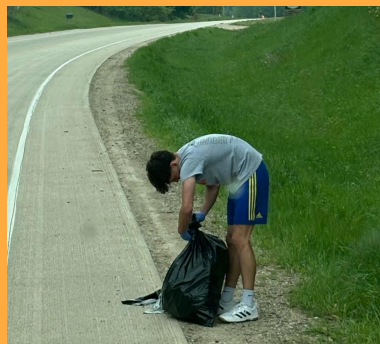

The High School Track & Field Team annually volunteers with the Horicon Lions Club to clean up trash on Hwy V outside of town. Thank you for serving your community T & F!

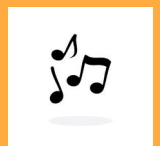
