Exams: Students may take any AP exam they choose. Students will be more prepared for an exam if they have completed an advanced course in that subject, but it is not required. While most colleges award credit for AP, students are strongly encouraged to check with specific colleges about their AP policies. Please check all exams you plan to take below.

Refunds: If you register to take a test and later cancel your registration or do not attend the scheduled test time, you will receive a partial refund of \$70. Late students will not be admitted and there are no make up exams. Late testing is allowed only under very limited emergency circumstances.

Mandatory Pre-Administration Session: All students taking AP exams are required to attend a pre-administration session on Tuesday, April 24 at 7:10 am in the lecture hall.

-OVER-

Students are expected to attend the full school day on the day of their exams. They are not excused from classes other than during their scheduled exam time. Students will receive an extended lunch period of approximately one hour on the day of their exam, depending on the timing of their exam. With parent permission, students may leave campus during lunch on the day of their exam.
