

NOTICE

PARENTS AND STUDENTS ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT DIRECTORY INFORMATION ON STUDENTS WILL BE RELEASED TO REQUESTING PARTIES UNLESS PARENTS NOTIFY THEIR CHILD'S SCHOOL IN WRITING THAT SOME OR ALL DIRECTORY INFORMATION BE WITHHELD. WISCONSIN STATUTE, S. 118.125 (2)(J) STATES THAT SCHOOL DISTRICTS MAY DISCLOSE DIRECTORY DATA WITH RESPECT TO EACH PUPIL TO ANY PERSON, PROVIDED THE SCHOOL HAS NOTIFIED EACH PUPIL'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN AND GIVEN THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN A REASONABLE TIME TO INFORM THE SCHOOL THAT ALL OR PART OF THE DIRECTORY DATA MAY NOT BE RELEASED.

"DIRECTORY DATA" means those pupil records which include the pupil's name, address, telephone listing, date and place of birth, grade level, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, honors and awards received, and photographs of any of the above.

ANY PARENT OR GUARDIAN, (OR STUDENT 18 YEARS OF AGE) MAY EXEMPT HIS/HER CHILD FROM ALL OR PARTS OF THE DIRECTORY DATA LIST BY NOTIFYING THE SCHOOL THE CHILD IS ATTENDING IN WRITING BY SEPTEMBER 30. IF THERE IS NO NOTICE SENT TO THE SCHOOL, THE STUDENT WILL BE INCLUDED ON THE LIST.

NOTICE

It is the policy of the Horicon School District that no person may be denied admission to any public school in this district or be denied participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be discriminated against in any curricular, extracurricular, pupil service, recreational, or other program or activity because of the person's sex, race, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability as required by s. 118.13, Wis. Stats. This policy also prohibits discrimination as defined by Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972 (sex), Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (race and national origin), Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (handicap), and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (disability).

The district encourages informal resolution of complaints under this policy. A formal complaint resolution procedure is available, however, to address allegations of violations of the policy in the Horicon School District.
