Tuesday, Dec. 22 — 2 to 4 p.m.
Dodge County Fairgrounds

Marshfield Medical Center-Beaver Dam is coordinating a **free** dairy, meat, fruit and produce distribution event to provide residents with surplus products. The program is open to everyone, but there is a limit of one box per household. Please use Highway W to access Fabisch Road and follow all signs and traffic control. Vehicles will make two lanes side by side as they enter the Fairgrounds. Upon exiting, vehicles will be asked to travel south on High Point Road to Highway W.

The event is a collaboration between MMC-BD, Feeding America Eastern Wisconsin, the United States Department of Agriculture and Second Harvest Foodbank of Southern Wisconsin.

Residents in need who lack transportation to the Fairgrounds can contact Beaver Dam Public Transit the morning of Tuesday, Dec. 22, to schedule the delivery of a food box to their home/residence by calling 920-885-4800. Transportation will be provided as availability allows.
