### **Special Education Teacher Assistant**

#### Job Summary

Horicon School District is seeking to employ a Special Education Teacher Assistant to assist in a special education classroom for 7.0 hours per day for the 2017-2018 school year. This position requires knowledge of and experience in behavior management strategies as well as adaptability to children's physical and emotional needs. The individual hired should possess good interpersonal skills. The Teacher Assistant would be expected to assist with this student's personal care needs, support with instruction, and daily classroom functioning of students with disabilities under the direction of the Special Education Teacher.

Location – Horicon Junior Senior High School

#### Required Qualifications:

Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction Certification as a Special Education Program Aide or as a Certified Teacher (or be eligible to obtain licensure) is required. Highly Qualified Coursework will also need to be completed.
