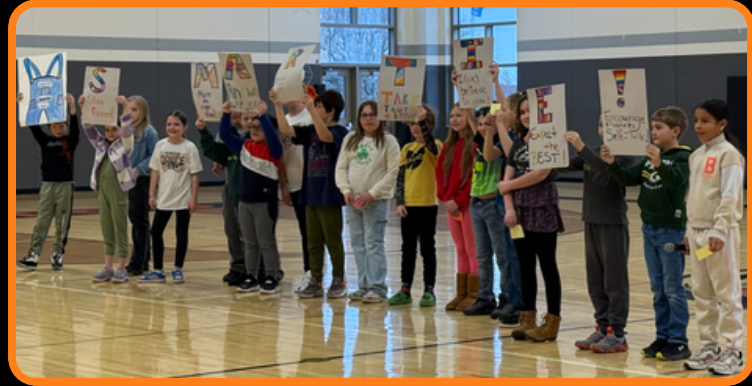
Juniors & Seniors who need bus transportation may ride the regular morning bus and will be supervised at school until classes begin.

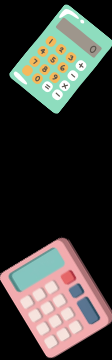

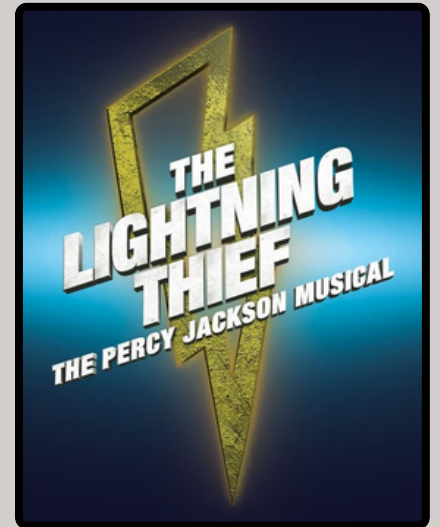
